11 2. The Receiver is authorized to sell any securities that would otherwise be
12 distributable to The Eliv Group, LLC (“Claimant”) as a Class 4 Investor Claimant pursuant to the
13 Distribution Plan.

14 3. The Receiver is further authorized to distribute the proceeds of the sale of
15 securities, net of any commissions and fees, and net of any additional amount withheld in the Tax
16 Holding Account, to the United States Attorney’s Office for the Northern District of New York
17 on account of Claimant’s Class 4 Investor Claim.
